Definitions



Scoring

Partially Proficient – scoring below 200

Proficient – scoring 200 to 249

Advanced Proficient – scoring above 250

Perfect Score - 300

AYP

(Adequate Yearly Progress)

- Established by NCLB
- Measures yearly progress based on standardized tests
- Minimum level of improvement that school districts must attain each year
- Percent of students achieving proficient and advanced proficient scores
- Private schools do not have to make AYP
- Source of controversy

DFG
