REPRESENTATIVE AND DELIBERATIVE GROUPS

The Board directs the Superintendent, whenever appropriate, to seek the counsel of existing employee groups or to form ad hoc groups to gain the most complete and reliable information possible on which to base decisions.

Members or organizations of the staff may initiate consideration of policies which, after being processed through regular administrative channels, will be considered by the Board.

In developing rules, regulations, and arrangements for the operation of the school system, the Superintendent shall include at the planning stage, whenever feasible, those employees who will be affected by such provisions.

He/she shall also evolve with professional and nonprofessional employees channels for the ready intercommunication of ideas and feelings regarding the operation of the schools. He/she shall weigh with care the counsel given by employees, especially that given by groups designated to represent large segments of the staff, and shall inform the Board of all such counsels in presenting reports of administrative action.

Provisions of current negotiated agreements must be honored in formation and utilization of such employee advisory councils.
