

ASSIGNMENT; TRANSFER

The chief school administrator shall make certified staff assignments in the manner best calculated, in his/her judgment, to enhance the educational program.

Teaching, supervisory and administrative personnel are subject to assignment and transfer after recommendation of the chief school administrator and approval by the board of education. Procedures for such transfers shall comply with provisions of current negotiated agreements and state and federal law. Particular attention shall be paid to ensuring that there shall be equivalence of teachers and administrative staff among the schools. Discrimination in assignment, transfer and promotion shall not be tolerated (see 2224, 41111 and 4111.1).

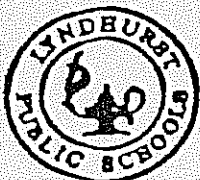
