The Lyndhurst Board of Education recognizes the need of each individual student to respect, dignity and privacy. Therefore the Board will not permit needless public labeling of any student.

Consistent with the New Jersey Administrative Code 6:28-2.1(g) the Board will not permit the needless public labeling of educationally handicapped pupils.

SPECIAL EDUCATION: NEEDLESS PUBLIC LABELING
OF STUDENTS

Every effort shall be made to prevent needless public labeling or other attendant publicity regarding educationally handicapped pupils, including the needless use of pupil names at public meetings or in Board of Education meetings. In this respect a code designation shall be used instead of a pupil's name. The Superintendent of Schools shall maintain the code list for the use of those who have a need to know.

Release of information regarding individual pupils or classes to outside agencies or persons outside of the Lyndhurst Public Schools shall not be made unless parental permission is obtained in writing or access is permitted under N.J.A.C. 6:3-2.5.

Personally identifiable data shall be kept confidential;

Personally identifiable data shall not be included in public acts and records, except upon the written request of the parent or adult pupil;

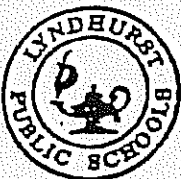
All pupil records shall be maintained according to 6:3-2.5.

The avoidance of public labeling shall include, but is not limited to public address announcements, classrooms, signs, open circulation of documents designating an individual pupil or class as handicapped, or open circulation of photographs and audio or videotapes.
