ELEMENTARY TEACHER/COACH RE:HIGH SCHOOL COACHING OBLIGATIONS

The Lyndhurst Board of Education recognizes that some elementary teaching staff serve as coaches for high school athletic activities. While the board considers the teaching time obligations and contract to be of prime importance, it also recognizes that coaches must be able to meet contractual league obligations relative to the starting time of games and contests. Therefore, procedures and/or guidelines have been established in regard to elementary coach dismissals.

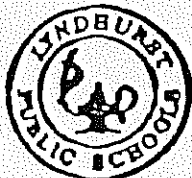
ELEMENTARY TEACHER/COACH RE:HIGH SCHOOL COACHING OBLIGATIONS

PROCEDURES AND/OR GUIDELINES

1. Elementary teachers/coaches are not to be excused early from teaching obligations for regular practice sessions and home athletic contests (barring extenuating circumstances).
2. Elementary teacher/coaches are to be dismissed early on days of away athletic contests. Coaches must maintain proper supervision and be able to meet contractual league obligations relative to the starting time of contests. Time of dismissal is to be based upon the bus departure schedule. Professional discretion of the teacher/coach and building principal should dictate the above decision.
3. Each and every coach is expected to organize and supervise the team to insure adherence to the time schedules.
