District Goals 2011-2012

1. All students in grades K-8 will participate in a locally designed program to increase technology skills and proficiency.

As a result, by June 2012, 100% of staff will provide students with technology enhanced lessons at least 2 times a month. Documentation to be noted in lesson plans.

2. All students in grades K-12 will participate in a locally designed program to increase the integration of technology across the curriculum.

As a result, by June 2012, 100% of students in grades K-12 will present portfolios containing evidence representing the completion of technology applications in 3 content areas.

3. All students in grades 1-12 will participate in a locally designed program to enhance writing skills across the curriculum.

As a result, by June 2012, 90% of students in grades 1-12 will submit a portfolio containing writing samples demonstrating growth based on a locally designed assessment criteria. These writing folders will be promoted with the student.

4. All students in grade 9 will participate in a shared science program, utilizing the instruction and resources from the Hackensack Meadowlands.

As a result, by June 2012, 90% of our students will demonstrate content proficiency by successfully passing a science activity measured by locally designed assessment criteria.

5. All students in grades 3-8 will participate in locally designed benchmark assessments to identify skills, which need to be targeted in order to increase the number of proficient/advanced proficient scores on the mathematics portion of the NJASK.

As a result, by August 2012, 10% of our students in grades 4-8 will demonstrate an increase in their NJASK mathematics score.

6. All special education students in grades K-12 will participate in the district established student learning goals with the assistance of a district-wide inclusion program.

As a result 50% of all special education students will meet the above mentioned criteria for district goals 1-5.
