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To Parents of 2017-18 General Education PK-3 and PK-4 Students,

We are so excited to welcome a new group of Pre-Kindergarten students to our district family in September of 2017!

We apologize for the limited information available at this time for the 2017-18 PK-3 and PK-4 programs. We offer this communication to offer a glimpse into our current programming and share our plans for the upcoming school year.

At the start of the 2016-17 school year, the Lyndhurst Public Schools acquired the half-day PK-4 program from the township. We then added on the half-day PK-3 program as well as a full-day PK-4 classroom. To allow for a smooth transition, we followed suit with the program tuition that was in place.

In our district's quest to continually improve our services, we remain in the planning process for next year's PK programs. This includes close examination of the number of students we can accommodate in each program, the possibility of including before/after care services for our full day programs, the number of locations that can offer PK, and the lowest possible cost we can ask for in return for high-quality PK programming.

Right now, the half-day PK-4 program is offered in Community School and the full-day PK-4 program takes place at Washington School. Our current half-day PK-3 classes are housed at our Lighthouse Campus, [601 Riverside Ave.](#)

Currently, half day programs are \$10/school day and full day programs are \$20/school day. As of now, Pre-K students do not wear the official school wear, but do dress comfortably in the clothes of their choice.

The District News section of our website was recently updated on January 23rd stating Pre-K information would be forthcoming in March. Of course, we recognize the eagerness of parents to know more precise information in order to plan for the upcoming school year. However, given our desire to offer the best,

most widespread programming to as many Pre-K families that our facilities can provide, our team does need until March to determine our enrollment procedures and offer a final, comprehensive, detailed communication about the registration for 2017-18 that is best for everyone.
