Instructions for Lyndhurst Library Sci-fi 2017 Writing Contest

1. All stories must be between five to ten pages.
2. Stories must contain some element of science fiction that plays a major role. (The story itself can be about anything. If you want your story to be about a romance just use some element of science fiction like time travel to make it acceptable.)
3. Put your title, name, grade and a few keywords words about the science fiction elements you included on a cover page. Be sure to add a way to contact you. If you prefer to have us contact your teacher make sure you put their contact information on the cover of your story.
4. All stories must be submitted before the deadline 4 pm on November 30th.
