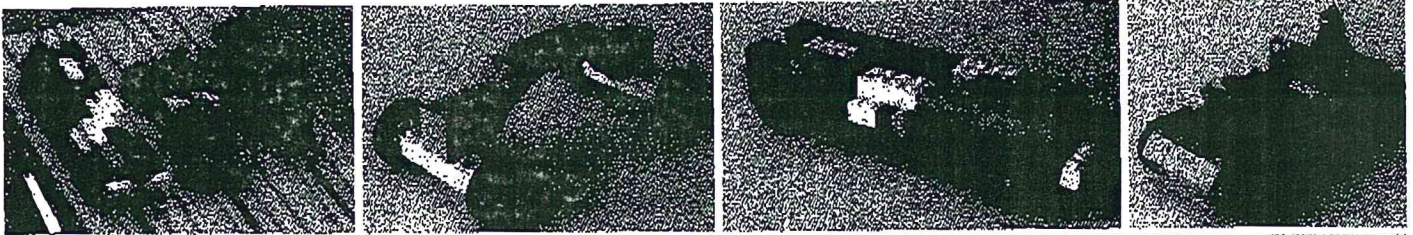


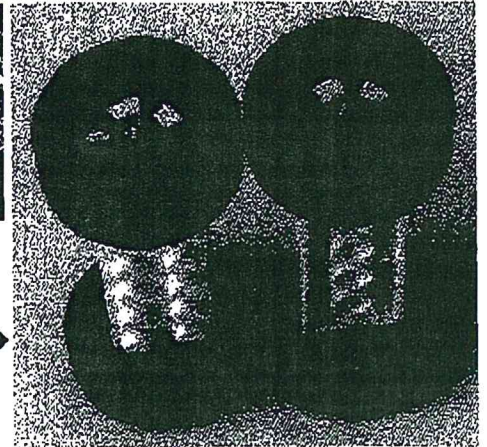
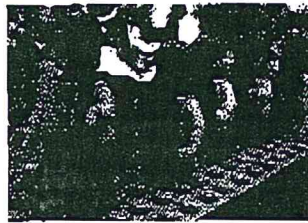
Pack 86 is hosting the 2017 Lego®-Cub Derby

It's all free. It's all fun!!!

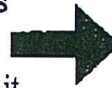


Cars can be built at home or at event. It is your racer's choice.



IMPORTANT

- The car must use the standard Lego Derby wheels and axles (provided at event, so leave room or an 6 x 2 nub, thick block).
- The car must have 3/8 in. clearance underneath the body so it does not rub on the track.



Other Pine Wood Derby Race Rules

- All cars will pass inspection. This is for fun, but we want the racer to have the full derby experience like a real cub scout.
- If you borrow any Legos, please return at the end of the races.
- If the car loses a piece, or is otherwise damaged, the racer can fix at will. So take your time.
- Everyone is a winner!
