

Summer Projects 2014

Jefferson School

1. Replaced HVAC Unit #4 on multi-purpose room
2. Refinished gym floor
3. Installed expansion tank on boiler

Columbus School

1. Installed three (3) classroom bathrooms for kindergarten
2. Renovated boys/girls bathrooms
3. Waterproofed basement classroom from the outside to eliminate water penetration

Lincoln School

1. Replaced lower roof of building
2. Replaced the VCT flooring in the rear entrance of building
3. Sanded three (3) classroom floors to original base
4. Replaced hand rail at rear of the building

Washington School

1. Replaced all windows in the entire building
2. Installation of all new shades all windows
3. Installation of one (1) classroom bathroom for kindergarten
4. Refinished gym floor

Roosevelt School

1. Sanded three (3) floors to original base
2. Installed partition in media room
3. Removal of mulch and installation of river stone on perimeter of front fence area
4. Removal of front fence (rotted out) replaced with slatted fence only to protect air conditioner units
5. Removal of 5'x58' mulch area and replace with concrete directly in front of the building

Franklin School

1. Installation of three (3) classroom bathrooms for kindergarten
2. Installation of instant hot water tank by boiler
3. Installation of all new stair treads for entire school (four flights of stairs both sides of building as well as entrance)

Community School

1. Painted all three (3) classrooms

Memorial Campus

1. Installation of 8600 square feet of classroom space and finish exterior of the building-complete tie into existing building for all security, data, communication etc.

Lyndhurst High School

1. Replacement of heating coil above band wing
2. Refinished gym floor
3. Installation of sheet rock walls in the athletic office
4. Replacement of two (2) HVAC units in the field house
5. Professionally groom the entire football field
6. Removal of 150 cubic yards of debris from the basement behind the boiler room

All buildings received the following:

1. Painted as needed
2. All floors waxed and poly
3. All boilers opened and inspected
4. All fire extinguishers inspected and replaced as necessary
5. All fire alarms tested
6. Replacement of lunch tables as needed (requested)
7. Moved 34 staff members and over 1200 boxes for reconfiguration of 3rd grade and additional staff movement
