1. BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lyndhurst Board of Education, County of Bergen, approve the preliminary 2020-2021 school year budget as follows:

- 3. WHEREAS, the Lyndhurst Board of Education policy #6471 and NJAC 6A:23B-1.2(b) provides that the Board of Education shall establish in the annual school budget a maximum expenditure amount that may be allotted for such travel and expense reimbursement for the 2020-2021 school year.

WHEREAS, the Lyndhurst Board of Education appropriated \$52,000.00 for travel during the 2019-2020 school year and has spent \$5,621.43 as of March 24, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Lyndhurst Board of Education hereby establishes the school district travel maximum for the 2020-2021 school year at the sum of \$56,000.00 and

BE IT RESOLVED that the School Business Administrator shall track and record these costs to ensure that the maximum amount is not exceeded.

- 4. BE IT RESOLVED, in accordance with N.J.S.A. 6A:23A-10.3(b)1, that the 2020-2021 school year budget includes the automatic enrollment adjustment in the amount of \$408,576.00 to be approved by the Lyndhurst Board of Education.
- 5. BE IT RESOLVED, that the Lyndhurst Board of Education approve the SEMI Action Plan for the 2019-2020 school year.
