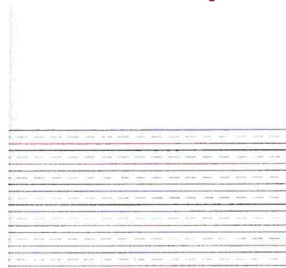

- 1 Package of Napkins
