



2021-2022 Testing for Lead in School Drinking Water Statement of Assurance (SOA)

SOA due date: June 30, 2022

1. The purpose of the SOA is to confirm that water testing for lead was completed in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A:26-12.4, required public notifications are provided, and alternate drinking water sources have been made available as required based on the testing results. The submission of a SOA is required regardless of whether an exemption from lead water testing has been granted.

SOA Completion Instructions:

The information listed below is required to complete the SOA form:

1. Results of lead water testing by a certified laboratory for all facilities serving students and staff;
2. The web address of the water testing results posted on the reporting entity's webpage;
3. The web address of the Notice of Exceedance Letter posted on your entity's webpage, if applicable; and
4. A Department-approved water testing exemption request and web address of posted exemption approval letter, if applicable

If you do not have access to the above information, you will not be able to complete the SOA and should not proceed to the next screen. All data entry fields must be completed in one sitting. Only one SOA should be completed for an entity; a subsequent submission will replace the prior submission. *

An exemption approval from the Department must be made available for inspection at the school facility and posted on the entity's website. **Do not proceed with the SOA unless the website link(s) to the required public reporting are live.**

If you plan to request an exemption or are waiting to receive Department approval for an exemption request, exit the SOA application until the exemption approval is received.

3) The entity will maintain compliance with all applicable laws, codes, and regulations governing the provision of potable drinking water and testing of drinking water for lead including, but not limited to, N.J.A.C. 6A:26-12.4; the Safe Drinking Water Act, N.J.S.A. 58:12A-1 et seq., and the rules promulgated pursuant thereto, N.J.A.C. 7:10 and N.J.A.C. 6A:26-6, Planning and Construction Standards for School Facilities. *
