- Distribution will take place starting September 8th
- Procedures will be developed to effectively distribute devices by grade level/buildings

- Longer daily time schedule due to subject content
- Counseling Services
- Time slot for lunch
- Full student schedule followed (all classes)
- Integrity of schedule rotations
- Daily teacher office hours

# High School Athletics

- Strict guidelines and procedures as governed by the NJSIAA
- Summer workouts end August 28th
- August 29th through September 13th (two week hiatus)
- September 14th (Fall practices commence)
- Competition begins for all sports by October 2nd
- All fall sports regular seasons conclude by November 12th
- Varied post season schedules and play extensions to November 22nd for teams not in the postseason

# Special Education/ESL

- Special education teachers will continue to adhere to the child's IEP and accommodate and modify course work as appropriate.
- Special Education teachers will participate in Google Meet and/or Zoom sessions.
- Should you have any question or concerns regarding your child, please communicate with your child's case manager. An IEP is a living document that can be modified at any time to support and accommodate a child's needs.
